### Selection Procedure/ Admission

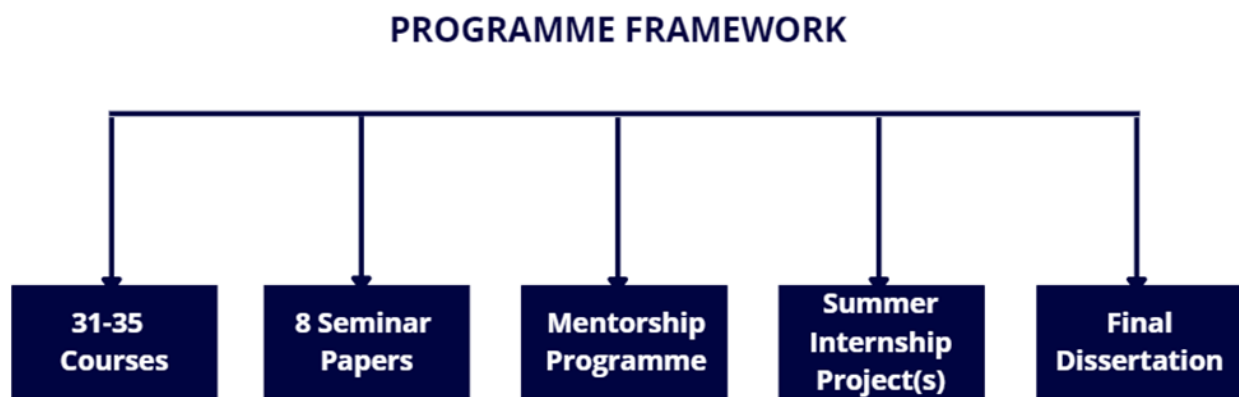
Students who intend to pursue a Master of Management Studies (M.M.S.) degree must pass an entrance examination administered by the respective authorities.

For taking admission in this programme, applicants must crack the MAH-MBA CET Exam successfully in order to be considered.

The selection of Students for M.M.S. programme is conducted through the common admission process i.e. CAP Rounds; carried out by DTE, Maharashtra.

## Programme/Course Framework

The Course duration of two years is divided into four semesters. The first and the second semester is same for all the students enrolled in this programme. After summer internship project(s), students choose their intended area of specialization i.e. Finance, Marketing, Operations, System and Human resource. All of the disciplines taught here place a strong emphasis on dynamic, practical, and industry-relevant knowledge and skills.

## Master of Science in Finance



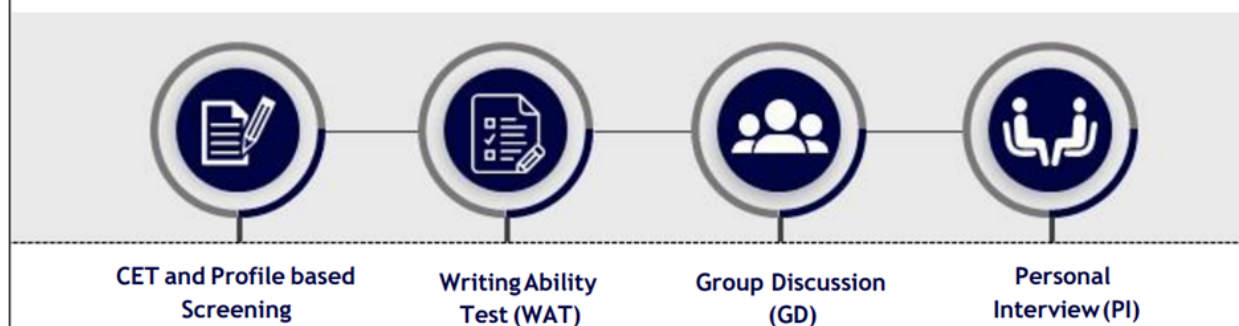

The desirable candidates will apply on the portal of the institute for admission to M.Sc. in Finance (M.Fin.) Programme. The candidates should have appeared for MH-CET 2022 or CAT 2021 to be eligible for the process. The application form will be opened for a stipulated period for applying to the admission process of M.Sc. Finance.

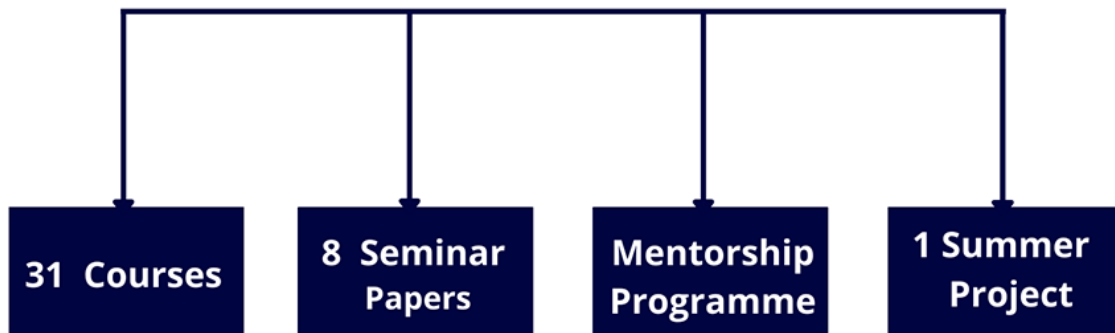

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# Master of Human Resource Development



## Intake

## Selection Procedure/ Admission

The admission procedure consists of:

- Written Test (WT) - 100 marks
- In Person Assessment (IPA) - 100 marks

### In Person Assessment (IPA) includes

- Group Activity – 40 marks
- Personal Interview – 50 marks
- Written Ability Test – 10 marks

The written test consists of 100 questions for 1 mark each. The questions are multiple choice questions where the correct response is scored as 1 depending upon the correct and desired choice. 100 questions include:

- 20 questions on Numerical Ability (NA)
- 20 questions on General and Business Environment Awareness (GA)
- 20 questions on Human Behavior Aspect (HB)
- 20 questions on Group Dynamics (GD)
- 20 questions on Individual Behavior (IB)

The Written Test scores have 0.25 negative marking for wrong answers in the Numerical ability and General and Business environment awareness sections. The other three sections do not have any negative marking.

The Group Activity is conducted in groups of 12-15 candidates, and behavior in the group demonstrating leadership, communication, interest in the group activity, initiative, and logical reasoning/ sequencing will be evaluated for 40 marks. Personal interviews are for 50 marks. The Written Aptitude Test (WAT) is of 10 marks and it entails writing a 300-word essay on "Statement of Purpose (SoP)" and pledging to take the course.

All the students applying for admission to the MHRD program appear for a Written Test. To qualify for In Person Assessment, a candidate must score Minimum 50 Marks for General Category and 45 Marks for Reserved Category in Written Test. From the list of qualified candidates, a reservation-based merit list of around 300 applicants is computed. The short-listed candidates undergo In Person Assessment (Group Activity, Personal Interviews and Written Aptitude Test). The Total Score is made up of Written Test (WT) and In-Person Assessment (IPA) Score. 30 students are selected as per the admission norms of MHRD.

## Eligibility

The candidate should have scored at least 60% marks in 10th Standard, SSC or its equivalent (at least 55% in case of candidates of reserved categories). The candidate should have scored at least 60% marks in 12th Standard, HSC or its

equivalent (at least 55% in case of candidates of reserved categories). The candidate should have passed minimum Three-year Duration Bachelor's Degree awarded by any of the Universities recognized by University Grants Commission or Association of Indian Universities in any discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent (at least 45% in case of candidates of reserved categories) OR appeared for the final year examination of any Bachelor's degree to be awarded by any of the Universities recognized by University Grants Commission or Association of Indian Universities in any discipline.

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## How to become a **JBIMS Student**

JBIMS admission for its two-year Masters in Management Studies (MMS) Program is through DTE CAP, which is held in July by the DTE Maharashtra. JBIMS Mumbai provides MMS and MSc Finance, MHRD as well as a part-time MBA in Management for working people. MAHCET, CMAT, CAT are the qualifying examinations for JBIMS admission. Based on their admission exam results, candidates are then invited to take a personal assessment examination.



Separate merit lists will be produced for JBIMS Mumbai admission under the MAH and All India categories.
