<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	Graduates in any discipline. Final year students of Graduate Courses can also apply.					
<b>MODE OF TEST (How to take the Test)</b>	<p><b>Candidate can take MAT as</b></p> <p>(i) Remote Proctored Internet Based Test (IBT) <b>or</b>  (ii) Paper Based Test (PBT) <b>or</b>  (iii) Computer Based Test (CBT) <b>or</b>  (iv) Paper Based Test and Remote Proctored Internet Based Test (PBT+IBT) <b>or</b>  (v) Double Remote Proctored Internet Based Test (IBT+IBT) <b>or</b>  (vi) Computer Based Test and Remote Proctored Internet Based Test (CBT+IBT) <b>or</b>  (vii) Paper Based Test and Computer Based Test (PBT+CBT) <b>or</b>  (viii) Double Computer Based Test (CBT+CBT)</p> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Candidates can opt for an additional mode of test (e.g. IBT+IBT, PBT+CBT, IBT+PBT, IBT+CBT, CBT+CBT) by paying an extra fee of ₹1200/- in addition to ₹2100/-.</li> <li>Candidates opting for additional test will have the benefit of selecting additional 2 Management Institutes for sending their scores in addition to existing option of selecting 5 Management Institutes i.e. they can select 7 Management Institutes in total.</li> </ul>
